

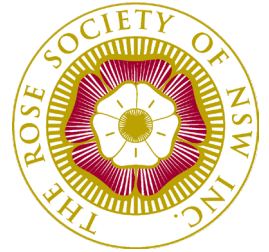

Airport transfers

Airport transfers from Sydney Airport are all via train from the Domestic Terminal. Trains depart every 10 minutes to Campbelltown or Macarthur Stations. Both stations are suitable and equal distance to all accommodation offers. Taxis and Ubers are available from both stations. Pre purchase of an Opal card is advised.

All train stations are accessible for wheelchairs, walkers, luggage etc, and there are *traveller with luggage* spaces at the front and back of every train carriage.
