Members meetings and activities

Modern life means that everyone is busy so we offer a range of meetings and activities to enable everyone to participate in some way, no matter where they live.

The Society holds regular evening Members Meetings from February to November, and other activities during the day and across the week. It also holds occasional zoom presentations—a blessing for many on cold wintry nights.

Our regular Members Meetings usually include guest speakers, cultural notes—so you know what to do when for your roses—a Show Bench Competition, a Q&A session and light refreshments. You are welcome to bring along a family member or friend because these meetings are open to the public.

Members Meetings are usually held each month on a Tuesday or Wednesday at 7pm in the Goodman Building Lecture Room (Hackney Road) at Adelaide Botanic Garden. There is ample parking in the Adelaide Botanic Garden car park next to the building.

A few times a year we visit somewhere of special interest to rose growers such as an historic property where roses feature, in lieu of a regular meeting. These are promoted in our club magazine, on the Members Section of the Society’s website and on our facebook and instagram pages.

Exhibiting

You may be surprised at how quickly your roses respond to the care learnt from cultural advice and the experiences of like-minded people. Within just a year or two, if not straight away, you may wish to take the plunge into exhibiting. It’s fun and pushes you to grow better roses. It also gives members of the public joy. The Society always ensures there is an opportunity to learn from top exhibitors about how to prepare and stage roses in the leadup to a show. This guidance is usually a feature of the Members Meeting before one of the Society’s main shows. We have also had the benefit of exhibiting workshops, presented by some of Australia’s top exhibitors.

Rose Shows

The Society holds an Autumn Rose Show each April and a Spring Rose Show each October. It has also held competitions for members at country shows—Uraidla and Mt Barker in recent years. On top of that, we sponsor rose prizes at a number of country shows.
